## Local Businessman Spreads Cheer - One Baseball at a Time Special care package for the troops inspires the new "Baseball Around The World" program

When Stoneham, MA resident, Ciro Whooley, heard that his family was putting together a care package for his cousin, Mike, stationed in Iraq, he knew he wanted to include something that would be a true reminder of home. For Whooley, a financial consultant and founder of the website ballclub.com, something baseball related was a natural choice. "My cousin is from New York and grew up a big Yankees fan and from my first game at Fenway watching Yaz playing in the outfield, I have been a Red Sox fan – we may be fans of two rival teams, but what we have in common is a love of the game," said Whooley.

And so, in order to bring the game and a bit of home to his cousin and the others stationed at his base, Whooley got together enough used baseball equipment to field a team, including baseballs, bats, gloves and a catcher's mitt, and sent it off to Mike's Second Battalion Sixth Marine Regiment.

The care package received rave reviews from Iraq. "For the few times of down time, it gave me and the guys a chance to feel a little closer to home" according to Mike. Since then, Mike has come home and joined the New York Police Department, but the baseball equipment stayed in Iraq continuing to be used for pickup games by the next group of guys in his platoon.

The package and the reaction it received, inspired Whooley to create the "Baseball Around The World" program. Through the program, hosted since November on ballclub.com, people are encouraged to donate used-but-usable baseball equipment that Whooley will process and send to other military bases, as well as children and children's organizations in need throughout the world. People who participate in the program and make a donation of usable equipment receive a souvenir baseball of their favorite major league team from Whooley as an acknowledgement of their good deed. "I think it's a great way to spread the love of the game and it's even "green" since we are finding a thoughtful and unique option for recycling used equipment," says Whooley.

Donations have already started to come in and Whooley looks to dramatically grow the program over the upcoming months.
